The abstract should be prepared using Times New Roman (Font Size 12) and submitted as a hard copy and CD. The abstracts can also be sent by e-mail. The name of the author presenting the paper should be in bold italics. The eligibility of the paper for oral / poster will be decided by the organizers.

Submission of Full paper

The full research paper should be prepared in the Current Science format and submitted as a hard copy (Times New Roman 12, 1.5 space) along with the compact disc. The organizers have planned to publish proceedings of the Seminar on actual cost basis. The full paper should be submitted at the time of registration.

Deadline Date

The Last date for submission of abstract is on **05 – 01 - 2009**, while filled in Registration Form should reach on or before **13 - 01 - 2009**.
